- 6. How mistaken and sad could it be for us if we fail to carry out this exercise accurately and think we have it all together? Luke 12: 16 21; Matthew 19: 16 25 (note verse 20)
- 7. While we are at it, what are some other requests that we can make? **Psalm 119: 33 40, Luke 11: 1**
